

PLWA Objectives

The objectives of the PLWA, as set out in the Application to form a Society under the Societies Act, are as follows:

to preserve, protect and enhance the aquatic ecosystem and lake environment of Pigeon Lake through the development of programs for the Pigeon Lake Watershed;

to undertake activities to restore the level of Pigeon Lake to prior set and agreed upon levels, and

to undertake activities to restore the fish habitat of Pigeon Lake.

In furtherance of the objectives, the PLWA shall:

monitor the development around the lake to ensure that the lake environment is protected;

promote the proper treatment of sewage disposal and drain-water for the long-term protection of the lake quality;

develop an education process, in conjunction with other interested parties around the lake, to restrict the use of chemicals and fertilizers;

develop realistic solutions for the optimization of the lake levels;

work with and assist all levels of government including municipalities, village councils and other interested parties in all matters that will enhance and protect the water quality and level of the lake;

work with other associations and groups that have similar objectives - education, etc.

develop and maintain a knowledge base of factors impacting water quality and quantity.

understand the problems that lead to the development of blue green algae and work on practicable and realistic solutions available;

work as a lobby group whenever and wherever required to achieve the mission and objectives of the association; and

assume a leadership role wherever and whenever necessary or required that will achieve the objectives outlined above.
