Last fall PLWA organized the cleaning of ten areas. Over 1600 pounds of debris was removed from our shores. This included an old boat hoist, 224 plastic bags, 1243 cigarette butts, 308 food wrappers and an amazing 973 fireworks. Thirteen tires were ‘donated’ to the Lakedell 4H clubs.
